The SCCA grading list has been published during the first quarter of each calendar year, then supplemented by updates from the ICCF rating system every March and September. The 2008 list was the last to calculate SCCA grades. From 2009, all grades are calculated on the ICCF system, and SCCA domestic events are administered on the ICCF webserver to allow results to be automatically fed into the ICCF system. From 2009, the ICCF grading list has been published quarterly.



## Grading List 2013

### October 2013 Notes

The fourth ICCF grading list of 2013 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 June and 31 August 2013. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 October and 31 December 2013.

Peter Bennett continues to accumulate grading norms towards the Scottish Master (SM) title - with the increased frequency of grading lists, this is the most prevalent route nowadays.

There are two new entrants on this list – both Campbells – new patron member Eoin, and returning member Iain.

As usual, a number of members have passed games milestones. SM Geoff Lloyd has hit the 600 mark, and Ian Marshall is now looking back at 400. Also on 400 is the ever-prolific Raymond Burrige, who clocked up an incredible 64 graded games in the last rating period!

### July 2013 Notes

The third ICCF grading list of 2013 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 March and 31 May 2013. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 July and 30 September 2013.

David Cumming secured the Scottish Master (SM) title with four consecutive grading norms of 2300+ in lists 2012/2 to 2013/1 inclusive – many congratulations to him!

With the publication of this ICCF rating list, Stephen Clark, Peter Smith and Wilf Taylor have all passed the 30-game mark and now have full grades – well done to them!

Games junkies Martin Harwick (42) and Raymond Burrige (38) lead the way once more in terms of games played during the last period, with Raymond also passing 300 games in total. Carlos Almarza Mato has passed the 700-game mark, while both Brian Goodwin and Derek Price exceeded the 200-game threshold.

Nine players have been removed from this list due to inactivity for two or more years.

### April 2013 Notes

The second ICCF grading list of 2013 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results from 1 December 2012 to 28 February 2013. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 April and 30 June 2013.

With the publication of this ICCF rating list, John Grant and Mark Smith have both passed the 30-game mark and now have full grades – well done to both. Alan Bell has passed the 2400 grading milestone.

David Dempster, resident in Australia, has now played 700+ games, and David Cumming, not resident in Australia, is past the 600 barrier. Arthur Knox has notched up his first century of games. Martin Hardwick and Raymond Burrige remain on energy supplements – a further 44 and 41 games posted respectively in the last period!

### January 2013 Notes

The first ICCF grading list of 2013 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results from 1 September 2012 to 30 November

2012. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 January and 31 March 2013.

With the publication of this ICCF rating list, Robert Montgomery has achieved a 2300+ rating for the first time, and with it, an SM norm. SIM Phil Giulian returns to active service as does Allan Petrie – welcome back both. New member Peter Smith collects his first provisional rating. Stephen Hilton played in the Webserver League last year and has revived his grading. A number of other League players are posting results and we'll include these when they reach provisional status.

GM David Kilgour has now completed 300 games. Raymond Burrige continues to play energetically, posting a further 38 results in the last quarter.

## Scottish Master Title

GM, SIM and IM titles are awarded by ICCF, and their qualifying conditions are explained on the [ICCF website](#) - follow the ICCF Titles links. The Scottish Master (SM) title is awarded by the SCCA, and its qualifying conditions are:

- Attaining the ICCF GM, SIM or IM title.
- Attaining 3 norms, without limit of time; one norm for each of the following:
  - (SCCA or) ICCF grade of 2300 or above, provided this grade is based on at least 30 results in total, and on at least 20 new results since any previous norm has been awarded for grade.
  - Outright winner of the SCCA Championship Final, or joint winner with at least 75% of total points. (Note that the SCCA Championship should be organised so that players play a minimum of 8 games for this condition to operate.)
  - IM norm.
  - 50% or more of the points in an ICCF World Semi-Final, or 60% or more of the points in an ICCF World Preliminary.
  - Winner of an ICCF World or European Master Class.
- Players must be members of the SCCA and have indicated that the SCCA is their primary CC body when norms are achieved, and the award of the title is subject to ratification by the SCCA Executive Committee.
