The SCCA grading list has been published during the first quarter of each calendar year, then supplemented by updates from the ICCF rating system every March and September. The 2008 list was the last to calculate SCCA grades. From 2009, all grades are calculated on the ICCF system, and SCCA domestic events are administered on the ICCF webserver to allow results to be automatically fed into the ICCF system. From 2009, the ICCF grading list has been published quarterly.



## Grading List 2016

### September 2016 Notes

The fourth ICCF grading list of 2016 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 June and 31 August 2016. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 October and 31 December 2016.

There were no additions to or deletions from this list. Movement across the grading bands featured David Cumming regaining 2300+; Raymond Burrige and Eoin Campbell reaching 2100+; Alan Armstrong hit 1900+ and Pat Moir climbed to 1600+.

Five new games centurions were recorded – David Cumming passed the 1100 games mark; Andrew Macmillen is now a 900+ player; Martin Hardwick vaulted 800+; and both Bill Cormack and Alastair Dawson climbed to 100+.

Our resident games addicts were relatively quiet (for them) – during this quarter, Andrew Macmillen totalled 52; Raymond Burrige and David Cumming 33; Martin Hardwick 32 and Eoin Campbell 23 games.

### July 2016 Notes

The third ICCF grading list of 2016 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 March and 31 May 2016. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 July and 30 September 2016.

There was one addition to this list – IM Clive Murden completed his transfer from Australia. Relatively little movement occurred across the grading bands this time, though Derek Price crossed the 2000 mark.

Five new games centurions were recorded – Raymond Burrige passed the 1000 games mark; Eoin Campbell is now a 400+ player; Arthur Knox and Charles Neil are both now 200+; and Robert Gilbert is now 100+.

Our resident games addicts behave as ever – during this quarter, Andrew Macmillen totalled 54; Raymond Burrige 50; Martin Hardwick 45; Carlos Almarza Mato and Eoin Campbell 44; and David Cumming 40 games.

### April 2016 Notes

The second ICCF grading list of 2016 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 December 2015 and 29 February 2016. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 April and 30 June 2016.

There were no additions or deletions to this list. Membership numbers are retained for easy reinstatement should any previously removed players return to the board.

Relatively little movement across the grading bands this time, though Alan Borwell crossed the 2300 mark.

Three new games centurions were recorded – Derek Coope and Martin Hardwick both passed the 700 mark, while Brian Goodwin is now a 300+ player.

Our resident games addicts remain unquenchable – during this quarter, Carlos Almarza Mato knocked up 67; Martin Hardwick 61; Eoin Campbell 47; Raymond Burrige 46; and David Cumming 32 games.

### January 2016 Notes

The first ICCF grading list of 2016 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 September and 30 November 2015. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 January and 31 March 2016.

There were five additions to this list – Colin Beveridge, John Dunn, Michael Dyer, A G Stewart and J Thornton, plus three deletions due to inactivity – Roland Fraser, A Sedstrem, and Peter Smith. Membership numbers are retained for easy reinstatement should any previously removed players return to the board.

Kevin Paine moved back to 2300+, Raymond Burrige regained 2100+ and Steve Murray reached 2000 – well done to all of them!

Two more players passed 1000 graded games – Alan Borwell and David Cumming. Raymond Burrige is now 900+, Andrew Macmillen 800+, Richard Beecham 400, Peter Bennett and Eoin Campbell are both 300+ and Tom Matheis 200+.

Our resident games addicts were again very active, with Raymond Burrige completing 59 ties, ahead of Andrew Macmillen on 55, Eoin Campbell and David Cumming each with 52 and Martin Hardwick on 34.

## *Scottish Master Title*

GM, SIM and IM titles are awarded by ICCF, and their qualifying conditions are explained on the [ICCF website](#) - follow the ICCF Titles links. The Scottish Master (SM) title is awarded by the SCCA, and its qualifying conditions are:

1. Attaining the ICCF GM, SIM or IM title.
2. Attaining 3 norms, without limit of time; one norm for each of the following:
  - o (SCCA or) ICCF grade of 2300 or above, provided this grade is based on at least 30 results in total, and on at least 20 new results since any previous norm has been awarded for grade.
  - o Outright winner of the SCCA Championship Final, or joint winner with at least 75% of total points. (Note that the SCCA Championship should be organised so that players play a minimum of 8 games for this condition to operate.)
  - o IM norm.
  - o 50% or more of the points in an ICCF World Semi-Final, or 60% or more of the points in an ICCF World Preliminary.
  - o Winner of an ICCF World or European Master Class.
3. Players must be members of the SCCA and have indicated that the SCCA is their primary CC body when norms are achieved, and the award of the title is subject to ratification by the SCCA Executive Committee.
