The SCCA grading list has been published during the first quarter of each calendar year, then supplemented by updates from the ICCF rating system every March and September. The 2008 list was the last to calculate SCCA grades. From 2009, all grades are calculated on the ICCF system, and SCCA domestic events are administered on the ICCF webserver to allow results to be automatically fed into the ICCF system. From 2009, the ICCF grading list has been published quarterly.



Grading List 2018

October 2018 Notes

The fourth ICCF grading list of 2018 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 June and 31 August 2018. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 October and 31 December 2018.

There were two additions (Alan Kearns and John Moore) and no deletions in this list. Upwards movements in grading bands were recorded by Jim Anderson (1900+), Eoin Campbell (2100+), Derek Coope (1800+), Robert Gilbert (1800+), John Grant (1700+), Arthur Knox (1400+), Iain Mackintosh (2400+) and Ian Marshall (1900+) – well done to all of them!

Five new games centurions were recorded – Carlos Almarza Mato reached 1500+, David Cumming got to 1400+, Martin Hardwick surpassed 1100, Eoin Campbell passed 800 and Charles Neil vaulted 300. Highest recorded games during this quarter were Martin Hardwick (60), David Cumming (45), Alan Kearns (44), Carlos Almarza Mato (43) and Eoin Campbell (42).

July 2018 Notes

The third ICCF grading list of 2018 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 March and 31 May 2018. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 July and 30 September 2018.

One player (Steve Pettigrew) was added to the list and there were no deletions. Upwards movements in grading bands were recorded by Martin Hardwick (1200+) and Arthur Kox (1300+) – well done to both of them!

Two new games centurions were recorded – Martin Hardwick reached 1000+ and Kevin Paine passed 200. Highest recorded games during this quarter were Martin Hardwick (57), Andrew Macmillen (52), Carlos Almarza Mato (49), and David Cumming (39).

[Ed: Kevin Paine secured his third and final Scottish Master (SM) norm and will receive his title and certificate at next year's AGM. Kevin achieved 3 grading norms of 2300+, separated by at least 20 new games, between 2015-18 – many congratulations!]

April 2018 Notes

The second ICCF grading list of 2018 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 December 2017 and 28 February 2018. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 April and 30 June 2018.

One addition (David Carswell) was recorded in this list. Three players were removed – Siegrun Macgilchrist, George Pyrich and Daniel Toye. Upwards movements in grading bands were recorded by John Armstrong (1500+), Derek Coope (1800+), and Andrew Macmillen (1600+) – well done to all of them!

Six new games centurions were recorded – Carlos Almarza Mato reached 1400+; David Cumming passed 1300; Andrew Macmillen vaulted 1200; Eoin Campbell surpassed 700; Peter Bennett went past 400 and Stephen Clark is now 200+. Highest recorded games during this quarter were Andrew Macmillen (52), Eoin Campbell (49), Carlos Almarza Mato (40) and Martin Hardwick (39).

January 2018 Notes

The first ICCF grading list of 2018 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 September and 30 November 2017. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 January and 31 March 2018.

Two additions were recorded in this list – Neil McEwan and Alan Sedstrem. Six players were removed due to inactivity – Jim Cairney, Tom Craig, Phil Giulian, Doug Harvey, Ian Jamieson and J Thornton. Mickey Blake climbed into the 2300+ grading band – congratulations!

Five new games centurions were recorded – Raymond Burridge reached 1200+; Iain Mackintosh passed the 700 mark; Gordon Anderson and Arthur Knox notched up 300+ and Alan Armstrong is now at 200+. Highest recorded games during this quarter were Eoin Campbell (50), Andrew Macmillen (45) and David Cumming (30).

Scottish Master Title

GM, SIM and IM titles are awarded by ICCF, and their qualifying conditions are explained on the ICCF website - follow the ICCF Titles links. The Scottish Master (SM) title is awarded by the SCCA, and its qualifying conditions are:

- 1. Attaining the ICCF GM, SIM or IM title.
- 2. Attaining 3 norms, without limit of time; one norm for each of the following:
 - (SCCA or) ICCF grade of 2300 or above, provided this grade is based on at least 30 results in total, and on at least 20 new results since any previous norm has been awarded for grade.
 - Outright winner of the SCCA Championship Final, or joint winner with at least 75% of total points. (Note that the SCCA Championship should be organised so that players play a minimum of 8 games for this condition to operate.)
 - IM norm.
 - 50% or more of the points in an ICCF World Semi-Final, or 60% or more of the points in an ICCF World Preliminary.
 - Winner of an ICCF World or European Master Class.
- 3. Players must be members of the SCCA and have indicated that the SCCA is their primary CC body when norms are achieved, and the award of the title is subject to ratification by the SCCA Executive Committee.
